1. Minutes of April 2, 2015

3. Timely Updates

Town Meeting

West Wheelock Gateway Zoning - new zoning that increases density, requires covered bike racks, etc.

Lyme Road MUP- Based on the work that was developed during the Safe-Routes-To-School, a MUP was proposed for the west side of Rte 10 and a sidewalk on the east side. There is a 50' pinch point at the Girl Brook dip. This summer the town will be rebuilding Lyme Road with a MUP, not the sidewalk on the east side. It will include a 12' MUP with a 6' tree lawn and 5' bike lanes on both sides. It was agreed to talk to our neighbors about both articles and to send an abbreviated LTE to the Valley News.

Education/Info Table - We also will have a table at the high school that Bill Young will set up early on the 12th. Bill will be at the table from 6 to 7 pm. The table will include the Moving Forward sign, Viz poster announcing the May 16th event and the handout from Dave Dostal.

Walk your Bike on the Sidewalk
