## 6. Reports from Directors

## **Director, Hank Tenney**

Thompson Terrace pavilion – cost will be up to \$18,000; there has been a \$7,500 donation. Hanover Improvement Society offered that if we raise \$13,000, they will give the final \$5,000. Hoping that the Lions, Trumbull Nelson will donate; Public Works will order wood in the winter – on pillars, engrave the names of the large donors. Will have picnic tables in the pavilion and four benches along the sides; Donations will be accepted to honor people and their names will go on the bench.

This should be done by little league season start up.

Baseball field at Thompson Terrace: Bases in the infield are being elongated to 70 ft.

Going to build a 2<sup>nd</sup> field at Farr Field (because they are accepting 2<sup>nd</sup> graders next season); will have a dirt infield; portable backstops will stay; can't put up a permanent fence because it is on a 100-year flood plain; going to put up a stone monument dedication to Mr. Farr (must go through zoning); Need to start working on signage for Greensboro Road

Etna Rink – parking lot is in; boards make a border for flooding; lights are fixed up. Ready to go

Lebanon Road white house (adjacent to Black Center) - nothing after town meeting

Soccer jamboree: There were 33 grade 3 & 4 soccer teams who participated; was a beautiful day and the event went smoothly
