The committee members gathered at the Kendal guest parking area at 1 pm and boarded the Kendal bus for the tour.... The committee proceeded to tour the following locations:

Leaving the Kendal property, the bus proceeded North on Route 10 (Lyme Road) to Goose Pond Road.

We then headed east on Goose Pond Road to Rennie Road, then to the intersection of Rennie Road with Hanover Center Road (Two Mile Road).

Stops were made at the intersection of Rennie Road and Hanover Center Road, and at the Parade Ground in Hanover Center.

The tour continued South on Hanover Center Road, turning onto Dogford Road, proceeding along "Upper Dogford Road" to "Lower Dogford Road", with a stop at the Nutt Farm.

From Dogford Road the tour continued south on Two Mile Road to Trumbull Hall, with another stop there.

The tour then proceeded easterly up Ruddsboro Road to Three Mile Road, turning northly onto Old Dana Road, and returning to Ruddsboro Road.

We continued on Ruddsboro Road to Blueberry Hill, where the tour group experienced the qualities of Ladd Road, Blueberry Hill Road, the upper portions of King Hill Road, Lakeview Road and then on to Brook Road, which connected through Lebanon to Stevens Road (which began in Lebanon and ended in Hanover).

Following Stevens Road into Hanover, the tour turned onto Etna Road.

Heading North on Two Mile Road to Goodfellow Road, we turned west and traveled the length of Goodfellow Road to its intersection with Lyme Road.

At Lyme Road, the tour headed south to the Kendal – the place of beginning!

The Tour adjourned at 4:15 PM....– with many thanks to our gracious bus driver John.
