**Review of Draft Travel Plan**

The implementation calendar was discussed first with many comments and suggestions made. It was decided that a SRTS committee is needed to finish some of the tasks on the implementation schedule such as producing a tip sheet, working with the PTOs to institute a regular walk/roll to school day, helping organize a bike rodeo, modifying an existing map for use showing meet up places and times, etc. Carolyn will attend the meeting at the Richmond School about organizing a PTO and help get Ray School parents interested. Other suggestions included:

- Coordinating with Advance Transit to make it easier for students to understand the bus system and the interim stops and need to change buses.
- Use the Bridgman Fund for covered bike racks.
- Installation of covered bike racks might be a good Eagle Scout project.
- Engage Dartmouth College Sustainability students to work with the schools on some of the programs recommended in the Travel Plan.
- Confirm that the “sidewalk amnesty” will be extended to all middle-schoolers.

Carolyn will incorporate comments and finalize the Travel Plan.
