Earth Week at the Schools:

Ray School will celebrate Earth Week with a series of activities—Monday's Go Green by riding the school bus, Tuesday's Consider Advance Transit, Wednesday's Walk or Ride a bike to school, Thursday's Try Carpooling and No-Idling, Friday's Visit the Kiosk and Meet the Town Manager.

Every class at Ray School will visit the kiosk on Friday. Teachers can use it and parents can peruse it during the week. The next week it will move to Richmond, the following week to the high school, and then it will be taken to Town Meeting. Lyn will take charge of moving of the kiosk. The kiosk should be at Ray School by Wednesday.

Lyn showed us the kiosk poster materials. Chris Kennedy will produce the posters for the kiosk. Lyn and Chris Soderquist will run a think tank at the high school on Friday, April 26, using Chris's CMiles tool. Nancy Carter and Peter Kulbacki will be present to hear the group's ideas on how to actualize its use in the community. Julia will introduce the CMiles program at the Ray School on Friday when she congratulates students on their Earth Week energy-saving activities and encourages them to continue.
