## **CASE No. Z2013-37** (SHUMWAY)

Harrison, Radisch and Waugh prepared the preliminary draft.

It was moved by Lappin, seconded by Harrison, to **DENY** the requested Special Exception under Article II, Table 204.8, pursuant to Section 322, to construct a communication/telecommunication facility, but **WITHOUT PREJUDICE** to the applicant to return to the Board at some future time if it believes it can make a more persuasive argument pursuant to the *Daniels* case than it can make at present concerning the non-availability of alternatives.

## **CASE No. Z2013-38** (SHUMWAY)

Harrison, Radisch and Waugh prepared the preliminary draft.

It was moved by Assmus, seconded by Lappin, to **DENY** the requested Variances under Article X, Section 1006, to construct a communication/telecommunication facility greater than 30' in height subject to the following conditions, and which is neither within less than 200 feet or greater than two miles from an existing tower, but **WITHOUT PREJUDICE** to the applicant to return to the Board at some future time if it believes it can make a more persuasive argument pursuant to the *Daniels* case than it can make at present concerning the non-availability of alternatives.

## **CASE No. Z2014-07** (SHUMWAY)

Harrison, Radisch and Waugh prepared the preliminary draft.

It was moved by Radisch, seconded by Harrison, to **GRANT** the requested Wetlands Special Exception under Article VII, Section 702 to allow impacts within the wetland buffer area in order to convert and reconfigure an existing woods road/trail into an access road associated with the construction of a personal wireless service facility. This grant is subject to the following condition:

- 1. That the work will be performed in substantial conformity with the plans and testimony presented.
- 2. The work will not be commenced until the applicant has returned to this Board and the tower is approved for this site.
