- a. The fish research facility shall be constructed in a manner consistent with plans included with this application.
- b. The applicant shall notify the Zoning Administrator if it intends to significantly increase the number of visitors to the site to participate in the fish research and education.

## CASE No. Z2015-02 (KAPPA KAPPA SOCIETY)

It was moved by Marion, seconded by Connolly, to **GRANT** a Special Exception to Kappa Kappa Kappa Society to recognize its current use as a Student Residence in the "I" Institution zone and allow expansion of its existing building at 1 Webster Avenue, Tax Map 37, Lot 20 in the "I" Institution zoning district, subject to the following conditions:

- A. The project shall be completed in substantial conformance with the plans as described in the application
- B. The completed facility will house not more than 23 students
