Radisch prepared the preliminary draft.

It was moved by Radisch, seconded by Harrison, to **GRANT** a Special Exception to Luke and Elizabeth Dann, property owners of record, to allow the keeping of poultry as an accessory use, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The chicken house and run will be constructed in substantial conformity with the materials submitted with the application.
- 2. No more than twelve chickens will be kept on the property.
- 3. No roosters will be kept on the property.
- 4. No slaughtering of chickens will occur on the property.
- 5. Any odors from the chicken house and chicken waste shall not be perceptible at the property boundary.
- 6. The chicken house and run will be enclosed on top and otherwise constructed to prevent predator break-ins.
- 7. The chicken feed will be enclosed in a rodent proof container.
- 8. The property owners will make arrangements for the care of the chickens when they are out of town.
- 9. The chicken house and run will be subject to inspection by officers or agents of the town who may order the removal of chickens if they believe the chickens pose a health risk.

There was a brief discussion about making "chickens" allowed with a zoning permit, rather than requiring the grant of a special exception.
