1. CASE No. Z2016-06 (WINGED VICTORY)

It was moved by Harrison, seconded by Donegan, to **DENY** a Variance in Case #24068-Z2016-06, but to **GRANT** a zoning permit to the applicant to repair the basement residential space damaged in the fire, subject to the following conditions:

- a. Pursuant to Section 807, the residential area to be restored may be no greater in volume or floor space than existed prior to the November 2015 fire, and;
- b. Pursuant to Section 807, the applicant shall commence construction for the restoration of the basement residential area prior to November 2017.

Z2016-05: CONTINUATION OF APPEAL OF AN ADMINISTRATIVE DECISION, NEW HAMPSHIRE ALPHA ASSOCIATION OF SIGMA ALPHA EPSILON, THAT THE CONTINUED USE OF THE PROPERTY AS A STUDENT RESIDENCE IS A VIOLATION **OF** THE **ZONING ORDINANCE** BECAUSE, DUE BY DARTMOUTH IT IS LONGER DERECOGNITION COLLEGE, NO OPERATING IN CONJUNCTION WITH AN INSTITUTIONAL USE. DECISION BEING APPEALED IS CONTAINED A LETTER FROM THE ZONING ADMINISTRATOR DATED FEBRUARY 12, 2016. THE PROPERTY IS LOCATED AT 38 COLLEGE ST. [PREVIOUSLY HEARD 03/24/2016]
