## 42 Blanchard Road: Deed Restriction Request/Owner: McWaters/ Rep: Greg Meeker of GMC Construction

Greg Meeker of GMC Construction (builder) was present as well as the owners, Mr. and Mrs. McWaters. A building plan was submitted to the BOH for an addition. Mr. Grossman reviewed the building plans and asked the applicant to make an appointment with the Board of Health to review the plans. After a review of the plans and room count, the Board determined that there was no need for a deed restriction. The dwelling currently has a four-bedroom septic system and the plans do not exceed that capacity.

### March DEP Task Force Meetings

Jack Spero, Lorin Johnson and Ira Grossman attended the DEP Task Force meeting held on March 1 in Worcester and discussed some of the topics at the meeting. Board members plan on attending the next meeting.

### 231 Ayer Road

A discussion occurred about the flow problem at this site; the owner and engineer were present at the previous meeting. The board reviewed the history of the upgrades, requests and current situation. Suggestions were made for some relief; the Board will consult with Mr. Grossman. The applicant will be present for the next scheduled meeting.

### Town Meeting Article for Mosquito Control

The article has been submitted, written and is on the warrant for Town Meeting in April. The Town Administrator stated that the Finance Committee has recommended the article. The Board is considering providing a handout at TM with some information for the voters.

There was a discussion on some of the questions that might arise at TM. Lorin Johnson informed us that he has spoken with Dr. Teleford of Central Mass Mosquito Control. The Board believes this is a good beginning measure toward mosquito control.

Tom Philippou will write up information on mosquito-borne illnesses for a handout.

#### <u>Other</u>

Two of the board members received an email from Kurt Hayes, of Lyme Light. Mr. Hayes presented a movie in Harvard several years ago. He proposed showing the movie again in Harvard "Under Your Skin" which is a documentary on Lyme Disease.

Tom Philippou moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:15; motions seconded by Lorin Johnson; vote: aye, unanimous.
