The Chairman called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Permits

51 Myrick Lane, Lot 72/IA System. The permit was signed. Whitney Road, Lot 1, New Construction. The permit was signed. Slough Road, Lot 3, New Construction. The permit was signed.

23 Sherry Road/Building Plans/Owner: Withers

Building plans were submitted for a lot, which was subdivided from the original house lot. According to the Assessor's records, the existing structure is a camp. It has no plumbing, heating. Mr. Grossman stated that it is not an existing habitable dwelling. Mr. Grossman will address these building plans.

PHER/PHEP Funding
