The Board reviewed an application and ancillary documents from Erin & Danno Sullivan, 5 Littleton Road. The homeowners have an innovative/alternative system and are required to connect to Town Sewer. Mr. Philippou moved to accept the application and authorize a betterment lien for the estimated total of this project, \$12,200. Ms. McCarthy seconds the motion; vote aye, unanimous.

The Board revised a draft of the Betterment Agreement. They opted to consider further edits at home and submit to Ms. O'Brien to assemble into a final draft for review and approval at the next meeting.
