### Land Stewardship Subcommittee 2016 Appointments

All three have agreed to serve another three-year term. Jim Breslauer made a motion to appoint the previously mentioned individuals to a three-year term of the Land Stewardship Subcommittee. ### Unbuildable Lot Requests - Bowers Road

Liz Allard explained the Commission has received request from two property owners along Bowers Road seeking to have their lots declared as unbuildable. Each lot has constraints to building due to the proximity to Bare Hill Pond. The lots are shown on Assessor's Map 26, Parcels 28 and 29. After a brief discussion Charlie Gorss made a motion to accept the information provided which details the unbuildable status of the previously mentioned lots. Don Ritchie seconded the motion. The vote was unanimously in favor of the motion.

#### Master Plan Steering Committee (MPSC) Update

Jaye Waldron stated the MPSC has changed public forum from March 3<sup>rd</sup> to March 24<sup>th</sup> at Volunteer's Hall.

#### **Update on Annual Town Meeting 2016 Warrant Articles**

The Board of Selectmen recently voted to remove the Commission's request for a warrant article in the amount of \$350,000.00 to purchase open space along Massachusetts Avenue because the proper procedure was not followed as it pertains to seeking funding for large projects. Members agreed the Commission needs to gain support early in the process when seeking funding for specific projects. The Commission agreed to seek an method to purchase the land.

#### Update to the Gifts of Land - Swabb, 100 Shaker Road

There was no update in regards to the price proposals for the removal of the structures at 100 Shaker Road.
