The meeting convened at 7:40 PM. Minutes were approved as amended.

<u>Post FY2016 Application Form:</u> Application Form has been posted on the Town Website for download by applicants. All applications are due to be submitted by September 26, 2014.

<u>Press Notification regarding Call for Grant Applications for FY2016:</u> Notification regarding application and dates due has been published in the Harvard Press and Harvard Hillside. John Lee will pick up CPC mail at Town Hall.

<u>Town Hall Notification of New Officers:</u> Didi submitted listing of new officers to Town Hall and CPC Coalition. Didi will notify both Town Hall and CPC Coalition regarding the addition of Pam Marston as the liaison for the Historical Commission.

<u>Follow-up on Parks and Recreation Stone Wall Restoration:</u> Joe Schmidt reported that approximately 32 feet of the stone wall has been done. Historical Commission has reviewed and approved.
