- Review proposed amendments to the tree planting policy made by the stakeholder reviews (P&R, Con Com and School Com). Review, create and amend draft documents related to implementation of the tree planting policy (application, table for potential locations / species, map of town corridor with numbered locations and table for tracking planted memorial trees. Review red bordered map of town owned land. The policy, application and tables were finalized, but the proposed location map and species table will not be fully created until a walk around the corridor meeting scheduled for May 19 at 6PM.
- 2. Expect that the earliest "new" round of memorial trees would be in the spring of 2016. Confirmed as approval by BOS is needed prior to implementing.
- 3. Review trees to plant this spring (includes a sugar maple adjacent to last year's first grade tree planting). Ordered gift trees for 64 first graders. This year's planting will likely be focused on South Shaker village (old maple removals).
- Discuss tree watering plan for summer. Approve order for some new tree gators (max number is ~15 trees). Christian to obtain 10 more tree watering bags with new tree order and Bill will verify with Tom Garfield that he is all set with COA to water.
- 5. Discuss timing and availability for pruning young trees (debris pickup coordinated with Rich Nota). Bill will coordinate with volunteers (Denis and Dennis?)—Sunday April 19?
- 6. Discuss funding for Elm Tree injections in June. Bill to call Dave Landry for detailed quote.
- 7. Article 9 of Warrant was reviewed. Tree Warden's approval should be inserted (preferably by DPW).
