Strategic and Capital Planning	 FY15 CPIC requests: Bromfield and Hildreth Weatherization Brian attended the Dec 19 CPIC meeting to review the projects and respond to questions. CPIC requested a summary of Town energy usage to determine the impact of previous projects. CPIC requested that the HES Weatherization project not impact any potential K-Wing mold situation. CPIC requested that the Bromfield Weatherization scope not conflict with the Science lab project. Town Energy Project Updates	 Energy Manager DOER Grant – application due in Feb.– H Steve has reached out to neighboring towns regarding a joint effort to commit to an energy manager as a shared resource. He contacted Bolton, Shirley, Ayer, Boxborough, Lancaster, Stow, Littleton. Shirley, Boxborough and Lancaster expressed interest.
