- Presentation by Ron Ostberg of the Municipal Buildings Task Force
- $\circ$  2 objectives for task force
  - Preserve and upgrade the buildings to meet current standards
  - Use the buildings to the advantage of residents.
- Additional Presentation points
  - Uses for old library
    - Community Center
    - Lease it out.
  - $\circ$  Idea of purchasing Catholic Church for COA or upgrading Hildredth House
  - We are not optimizing the use of the space that we have.
- Outlined request for \$\$\$ for the upcoming year. Request is \$75,000 Has already been presented to the Capital committee Funding would probably have to come from special Warrant article at Town meeting. Should be making this request to selectmen shortly.

  - Board of Health feels that this person's job is needed/required.
  - Finance Committee discussion on whether to recommend to leave admin position as is, subtract 1 hour, or eliminate the position. Tim is confident that we have the skill set in Town Hall to take on these admin duties.
  - Finance committee recommends to zero fund admin position by majority vote 4-2 with one abstaining.

- Motion to vote on overall Omnibus budget as presented subject to any union negotiations Vote was taken 5-0-1 in favor.
