CPIC Capital Article Recommendations: Keith, Marie, Debbie, Alan

- Process Overview discussion
- Advocating for capital exclusions for those requests not small enough for capital funds or not large enough to borrow over time.
- 11 Projects made the evaluation cut totaling \$722,856
 - o DPW Front-End Loader \$160K capital exclusion
 - Needs 2/3 vote at ATM
 - o DPW Dump Truck \$70K capital stabilization
 - \$60K savings by having school use replaced truck to meet their capital need
 - o HCTV Air Conditioning \$19,800 capital stabilization fund
 - recommend use of FY14 CPIC funds if passed at ATM
 - o Pond boat trailer parking \$30K capital stabilization fund
 - o Hidreth Elementary K-Wing Assessment \$20K capital stabilization fund
 - o Bromfield generator coverage expansion \$60K capital stabilization fund
 - expands to cover entire building
 - capacity exists on generator for expansion
 - o Bromfield entrance way concrete \$115K capital exclusion (not to exceed)
 - Needs 2/3 vote at ATM
 - o Bromfield HRU (Heat Recovery Unit) and Bath exhaust fans \$22.6K capital stabilization fund
 - o HES resurfacing front roadway \$50K capital stabilization fund
 - Project estimated at \$65K schools picking up \$15K difference
 - Question by Bruce of possible timing and potential impact on the Farmers Market in August?
 - o Police new cruiser \$29K recurring capital
 - o DPW compost facility \$10K recycling revolving account
 - ongoing operation costs by DPW budget

- Hildreth House and TBS Science lab projects did not meet the threshold for funding cutoff

 - o Bruce brought up the addition of or to make it and/or 5 Year life expectancy
 - o CPIC will discuss this change at next meeting
- Laura led a discussion around project size in addition to merit being considered.
