Bare Hill Rowers - fall roster, summer wrap-up, fall schedule

-BHRA offered a crew open house and was able to recruit 16 new learn to row kids. Currently on the team there are 56 Bromfield rowers and 40 AB rowers, for a total of 96. 13 crew kids graduated from Bromfield this past year. This year, there will be 8-10 Bromfield seniors. BHRA is asking for an exception to be made to the ratio of AB/Bromfield rowers. This year, they will be over by 13 kids from AB. BHRA said LTR is unique to Bromfield kids and this is how they are trying to grow the Bromfield side. Competition starts at the end of September, so BHRA is requesting a decision by P&R next meeting, Monday, Sept. 17. -There are 5 Harvard adults who are rowing in the morning 6am-8am. They rent equipment from BHRA.

2013 Triathlon

- Lion's Club gives \$25,000 back to the town throughout the year. Most of their fundraisers revolve around food and are weather dependent. They are interested in hosting a triathlon – it would help diversify their fundraising and interests. They talked to police department in Harvard and Bolton and they are in favor. They have hired a race management team to run the entire event. The proposed date is: Sunday, June 30. Transition area would be parking lot for the beach. Parking would be at the schools, library, etc. Hoping for 300 participants. John Lee requested of the Lion's Club: references for the race management company, "Town of Harvard" placed on the insurance rider, beach staff necessities. BJ moved to approve Bare Hill Triathlon, motion seconded and passed.
