Summary of discussion with Rich Nota

Connection permits would be issued by the DPW.

The property owner would need the following:

1/Trenching permit on town or town road lands

2/A permit for work on property owners land.

this permit application would identify pre-approved contractors for electrical, plumbing and trenching work. A general contractor or the property owner acting as the GC would be responsible for timing the inspections of all the sub-work for appropriate inspection and for the final inspection.

## Grinder pumps

Electrical and plumbing permits would be needed.

The HSC and Rich Nota agreed that a standard pump would be pre-selected for all to use, facilitating the HSC's ability to hold emergency reserves . A request to use a non-standard pump would first be presented to the HSC and if the merits of the request is approved it would then be specified and/or approved by the HSC consulting engineers.

The engineering firm is under contract to operate the water line and sewer plant.

A discussion ensued on identifying the Distribution Budget and the Treatment Budget and how the fees and charges would accrue to each.

DEP will require back up pumps

Action item: The HSC will meet with engineering firm to review all DEP requirements.
