Town Administrator's Report and Update

Review Pending Applications for Connection Permits

- The Board reviewed the applications of 12 Ayer Road (Edward and Brooke Grant), 7 Massachusetts Avenue (Rhonda Sprague), and 5 Pond Road (Mahogany Run Condominium Trust, Wendell Willard, Trustee).
- Mr. Hedrick moved to approve the sewer connection permit for 5 Pond Road, seconded by Ms. Russo all in favor with one absent.
- Mr. Hedrick moved to approve the sewer connection permit for 7 Massachusetts Avenue, seconded by Ms. Russo all in favor with one absent.
- Mr. Hedrick moved to approve the sewer connection permit for 12 Ayer Road, seconded by Ms. Russo all in favor with one absent.
- The Town Administrator provided the Commission with a copy of an email from Ethan Pride of 14 Ayer Road regarding his connection. He explained that Mr. Pride was not yet ready to connect and that he talked to Mr. Cormier (Al Cormier of D'Boss Construction and approved drainlayer here in Harvard) about being able to connect at the street now and have the line run from the street to his property and cap it on his property. This was being requested given the very close proximity of the street connections and if approved would reduce the potential for a possible issue for the Prides later on. The Commissioners discussed the matter and Mr. Hedrick moved to approve the request, seconded by Ms. Russo. Mr. Russo and Mr. Hedrick approved the request on a two to nothing. The Commissioners insisted that the contractor clearly mark the end of the pipe he will install for the Prides on their property.
