### <u>Discussion – James Arthur, Weston & Sampson</u>

Mr. Arthur, operator of the sewer treatment plant, was called in to explain the exceedingly large effluent numbers on the November 2013 monthly report filed with DEP. Because he did not have his 2013 log book, Mr. Arthur could not explain the high numbers; although he assumes either clerical error or mechanical failure. He will let Mr. Bragan know as soon as he reviews his notes. He reports the plant is operating satisfactorily at this time.

The operation is using between 6-9 thousand gallons per day depending on whether or not school is in session. Mr. Maiore proposes compiling a spreadsheet of a moving average curve.
