The meeting was called to order by Ms. Russo at 9:05 a.m.

Review & Approve Minutes of 5/21/2014

Mr. Hedrick moves to accept as presented; Ms. Russo seconds. Vote, aye, unanimous.

Review Pending Applications for Connection Permits

3 Oak Hill; Vilain – Mr. Maiore motions to waive 2014 connection fee and inspection. Mr. Maiore also moves to approve connection pending payment of connection fee. Mr. Hedrick seconds; vote aye, unanimous.

Town Administrator's Report & Update

 Damaged pump – one of two pumps at The Bromfield School has failed; will be replaced during week of June 23;

Consider Any Issues Relating to Connections

- ➤ Extending water line for Fire station and Hildreth House Mr. Bragan showed the Commission a diagram of the ledge profile. The trench being used for sewer needs to be deep enough to make a new water line go up hill. Hildreth House has low-water pressure problems in the summer time due to the uphill feed. Commission agrees that this is a viable solution, but is concerned about the cost to do so.
- Mr. Bragan advocated for another E1 pump to be located on the west side of the Town Hall because the building won't be rebuilt with a new foundation; existing system would be discontinued. Mr. Hedrick motioned to accept this recommendation; Mr. Maiore seconds. Vote, aye, unanimous.
- ➤ Residents on Old Boston Turnpike have not installed a water meter so the town is currently charging the maximum rate. The property has been connected for 6 months and the owners have been sent many requests for compliance. Mr. Maiore moves to send letter giving the property owners 30 days to install a meter; after which the Commission may exercise its right to charge a fine of \$300. Mr. Bragan will send a letter.
- Mr. Bragan will give Mr. Hedrick data about those in the district that have yet to apply for connection permits. Mr. Hedrick will call to check in with the property owners.
