PUBLIC HEARING NO. 1
MARCH 2, 2010

A Public Hearing was held by the Board of Trustees on Tuesday, March 2, 2010 at 7:35 p.m. in the Meeting Room, Municipal Building, 7 Maple Avenue.

PRESENT: Mayor Peter Swiderski, Trustee Bruce Jennings, Trustee Jeremiah Quinlan, Trustee Meg Walker, Trustee Nicola Armacost, Village Manager Francis A. Frobel, Village Attorney Marianne Stecich, and Village Clerk Susan Maggiotto.

CITIZENS: Eight (8).

Mayor Swiderski declared the Board in session for the purpose of conducting a Public Hearing in accordance with the legal notice that appeared in the February 12, 2010 issue of *The Rivertowns Enterprise* to consider the application of ExxonMobil Oil Corporation for demolition of the offshore central dock structure and catwalks for the former Mobil Tappan Terminal site as per the application dated January 15, 2010.

Mayor Swiderski: These are the metal catwalks you find around the two caissons which are located offshore out in the Hudson, as well as removal of a collapsed catwalk that has fallen into the river, and removal from the site and the Village.

Village Manager Frobel: Nothing to add to that, Mayor. A representative from the engineering team is here this evening, if there are any questions. It does come up later on in your agenda, as well, but this is the public hearing and you have summarized their activity.

Hearing no public comments, Mayor Swiderski asked for a motion to close the Public Hearing.
