

**VILLAGE OF HASTINGS-ON-HUDSON, NEW YORK**  
**BOARD OF TRUSTEES**  
**PUBLIC HEARING NO. 4**  
**MARCH 2, 2010**

A Public Hearing was held by the Board of Trustees on Tuesday, March 2, 2010 at 7:45 p.m. in the Meeting Room, Municipal Building, 7 Maple Avenue.

**PRESENT:** Mayor Peter Swiderski, Trustee Bruce Jennings, Trustee Jeremiah Quinlan, Trustee Meg Walker, Trustee Nicola Armacost, Village Manager Francis A. Frobela, Village Attorney Marianne Stecich, and Village Clerk Susan Maggiotto.

**CITIZENS:** Eight (8).

Mayor Swiderski declared the Board in session for the purpose of conducting a Public Hearing in accordance with the legal notice that appeared in the February 26, 2010 issue of *The Rivertowns Enterprise* to consider the advisability of adopting Proposed Local Law No. 4 of 2010 amending the Code of the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson, Westchester County, New York, Chapter 209, Parks and Recreation, to eliminate the maximum number of terms of Commission members.

**Mayor Swiderski:** This was a term limit limitation that existed, oddly enough, for the Parks and Rec committee and none other, other than the Zoning Board.

**Trustee Armacost:** And Ethics, which we have just dealt with. So now we will be consistent, more or less.

Hearing no further comment, Mayor Swiderski asked for a motion to close the Public Hearing.
