Mayor Kinnally declared the Board in session for the purpose of conducting a Public Hearing in accordance with the legal notice that appeared in the March 3, 2006 issue of *The Rivertowns Enterprise* to consider the advisability of adopting Proposed Local Law No. 1 of 2006 adopting the Senior Citizen/Disabled Rent Increase Exemption.

Mayor Kinnally: This being a public hearing, I would ask anyone who wishes to speak either in favor of, or in opposition to, the proposed local law please to come forward, give your name and address for the record.

This matter was the subject of discussions on at least two occasions. Our senior advocate is here. We have had input from her, and from the Manager and from the Deputy Village Manager about the scope of the project and the impact that it will have not only on our citizens but also on our budget.
