Petitions for leave to intervene must be received by 5:00 P.M. on **Thursday, November 17, 2016**. Such petition must satisfy the substantive requirements of 801 C.M.R. § 1.01(9). If possible, petitioners should also submit the petition to the Department in electronic format by e-mail attachment to dte.efiling@state.ma.us. The text of the e-mail or written petition must specify: (1) the name of the cable operator; (2) the docket number; (3) the name of the person submitting the filing; (4) that person’s municipal title, if any; and (5) a brief descriptive title of the document (e.g., petition to intervene or participate). The petition should also include the name, title, and telephone number of a person to contact in the event of questions about the filing.
