# **Budget Overview – Goals & Procedures**

M. Miville review past practice and procedures for reviewing the budgets.

- J. Hyde suggested adopting Robert's Rules and assigning a Parliamentarian.
- J. Pieroni: I would prefer a more relaxed atmosphere since this is not a political Board. We do create our own budget and therefore have a serious position. We don't have the responsibility of how the money is spent. The governing body makes those decisions and implements the budget.
- D. Pearl: Because it is our budget, we can add money to the budget. We cannot delve into policy. You can cut money for a program but it is a bottom line budget and they can run whatever program they decide.
- D. Pearl motioned to adopt Robert's Rules for considering motions. Seconded by T. Jennings. M. Miville motioned to table. Seconded by D. Pearl Vote unanimously in favor.

### **Meeting Schedule**

The Budget Committee discussed the potential for a Charter change which will move the Town election to March.

D. Pearl motioned to have the School Board and Town appear before the Budget Committee once the budget is finalized. Seconded by T. Jennings.

D. Pearl: It is confusing when the Administrator states his budget request prior to approval of the School Board. There is then a perception that there is already a cut made. We only deal with the final School Board budget.

Vote 6:5 motion carried

D. Pearl motioned that the Budget Committee request that the School Board submit and present their budget to the Committee on November 19<sup>th</sup>. Seconded J. Pieroni. Vote 10:1 motion carried

D. Pearl motioned that we place on the agenda for one week prior to review the current year's school budget. Seconded by C. Morneau Motion withdrawn.

D. Pearl motioned to make November 12<sup>th</sup> the first meeting. Seconded by J. Hyde. Vote unanimously in favor.
