Perpetual Care income around \$5,000 yearly, must be used in the year the income/interest was gained or we lose the funds.

Cindy checked a few years back with the attorney general to see if previous years funds could be withdrawn and the AG said no.

End of the year the chair writes a memo to withdraw any and all income earned.

The income has been used to apply towards moving fees that cost about \$16,000 yearly for all cemeteries to be mowed.

Posts are rotted, he will remove them this week. The same fencing would cost about \$10,000 and last 7-10 years (thought company would say 15 years).

Vinyl costs slightly more but will last longer.

May 8th spoke to Arnold Green (Business 485-5131) Home 485-9148

He suggested Oak Fence, his has lasted for over 45 years.

Questions to ask fence companies:

- Are they installing 6" of crushed stone/rock about 1" in diameter should be the side of each stone.
- Each post should be treated with tar to prevent rotting.

He's quite interested in having the look preserved. He might be able to put some funds toward it and also others to put funds towards it.
