The Trustee discussed the condition of the cedar fence at Head's Cemetery located on Pleasant Street in Hooksett. The current fence has been in place for approximately 13-16 years. Portions of the fence fell down this spring partially due to heavy and constant rains. Also, portions of the fence have rotted in the ground and could no longer support the structure of the fence.

Wally, Joanne and Tina discussed obtaining quotes from at three companies and two different types of fences. It was decided that cedar post and PVC would be looked into.

We looked into getting bids from two local companies in town and two companies from out of town. A lot of information was gathered such as fence style, material, warranty long and short term. It was noted that we should have the same information from each company on each style of fence so that we could make an equal comparison. Therefore, a little more information needs to be obtained before a decision is made.

We should have more information by the week of May 21st. Tina will contact the Town Council to see how soon the Cemetery Commission can be put on the agenda.

The Commission discussed possibilities of where the funds could come from and will discuss this with the Town Council as well.

Joanne inquired about perpetual care for the plants that are annually placed at four gravesites. Tina said she would provide those names and show her where they are located.
