- The funding will help with the costs of:
 - o Footbridge from parking area to trailhead
 - o 2 mi. routine trail construction
 - o 1 mi. trail construction over abandoned RR corridor.
 - o 1,000 ft elevated walkway materials
 - o 1,000 ft elevated walkway
 - Total cost would be around \$336,000
