

**Hooksett Sewer Commission
February 21, 2012
Minutes**

The meeting was called to order at 12:00 PM. Present were Chairman Sidney Baines, Commissioner Roger Bergeron, Superintendent Bruce Kudrick and Bethany Hague. Commissioner Frank Kotowski was excused.

FINANCIAL REPORT – There was no financial report.

SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT

VILLAGE WATER BILLS – After reviewing the water bills for the past few quarters the water usage seems to be exorbitantly high. Supt. Kudrick has been checking the meter, and it does not seem to be reading such high usage as Village keeps charging. Chairman Baines told Supt. Kudrick to put the water department on notice that the Commission was protesting the readings. He will continue to monitor the meters to compare with the water company.

KRUGER – Representatives from Kruger will be coming on Friday the 17th to do some more testing with an independent consultant.

SCHEDULED APPOINTMENTS

1103 HOOKSETT ROAD– FROACH LLC. - Artie Kalampalikis – Mr. Kalampalikis came before the board to ask for some financial relief because they have had to replace part of their sewer line due to what he and Supt. Kudrick believed to be a smashed pipe. The problem most likely occurred when the state did road work along Route 3, because another house near 1103 had to have their line replaced by the state. However, since some time has passed, the state has basically said that Mr. Kalampalikis had to prove without a doubt that the damage was done by the state work, which of course is impossible. The total amount to fix the problem may be up to \$10,000. After some discussion, Commissioner Bergeron made a motion to give Mr. Kalampalikis \$1500 to help with repairs. Chairman Baines seconded. All in favor.
