SUPERVISOR OF CHECKLIST (SoC) MINUTES

CALL THE ORDER

The mandatory meeting was called to order at 6:10 p.m. with a quorum present. The scheduled meeting time was 6 p.m. to 7 p.m.

ATTENDANCE

Chairman Mike Horne, Bob Ehlers and Sally Humphries.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting of June 20, 2011, were approved by Mike Horne and Sally Humphries. Bob Ehlers arrived at 6:40 p.m.

OLD BUSINESS

This meeting, called to initiate the purge of voter records, was rescheduled from July 13 due to a meeting conflict with the Hooksett Town Council.

Mike Horne received a letter from the Attorney General's office regarding Voter #149050778, who voted in both Hooksett and Manchester on November 9, 2010 election. The AG has stated that no further action will be taken, and that there is no compelling evidence for penalties. Mike will make a note in Election Net about the duplicate vote.

NEW BUSINESS

Mike estimates the "purge" list is about 1800 voters. The logistics of the mailing was discussed. A letter, not a postcard, is preferred due to the length of the letter. The cost of hiring a printing firm to fold, stuff, seal and imprint the mailing will be sought.

A motion was made by Bob Ehlers to accept the purge list as given by Election Net, after having reconciled the list against any recent voter registers. Seconded by Sally Humphries. Unanimously approved.

The letter will be dated July 29, 2011. A meeting of the Supervisors of the Check List will be scheduled for August 30, 2011, at 6 p.m. to allow for voter response to the mailing.

Don Riley, newly elected Town Moderator, expressed the desire to meet with the Supervisors of the Check List, and Linda Pischetola, the newly elected Town Clerk to plan with the 2012 Primaries this fall. The previous Town Moderator will also be invited.

ADJOURNMENT

The meeting adjourned at 7 p.m. on a motion made by Sally Humphries and seconded by Bob Ehlers. Unanimously approved.
