APPROVAL OF MINUTES

PUBLIC INPUT/VOTER REGISTRATIONS AND CHANGES: Two voters attended.

OLD BUSINESS

- ... National Right to Life Committee had requested election histories, but did not respond to questions. No data sent.
- ... Hooksett Board of Election Officers (Town Moderator, Town Clerk, Supervisors of the Check List) met as planned on October 11. Minutes have been posted.
- ... Regarding the checking or adjusting of Hooksett's six districts (wards) to rebalance according to the newest population figures, David Scanlan of the Secretary of State's office, advised Mike Horne that how it is done is entirely up to the Town of Hooksett. Discussion: Is there a time line by law and what does the Hooksett Town Charter require about district size. Input from Town Council to be sought.

NEW BUSINESS

- ... Unanimous approval for the removal of 2 voters who moved from Hooksett.
- ... Unanimous approval of 24 voters Pending Supervisor Approval.
- ... Unanimous approval of 2 voters in status of pending removal.
- ... Unanimous approval of 41 voters removed due to death notices by Division of Vital Records.
- ... Budget requirements for 2012-2013 to be considered by the Board of Election Officers and carried to Town Council by Don Riley, Town Moderator.
- ... Need of a laptop for Election Day procedures by the Supervisors of the Check List was discussed.
- ... Discussion on the need for assistant election officials to assist the Supervisors of the Check List in the upcoming Presidential Primaries. Don Riley, Town Moderator, to work on those details.
