APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting of October 27, 2012, were unanimously approved with amendments

OLD BUSINESS

- Redistricting -- discussion and meeting scheduled for Monday, January 28, to finalize new districts and means of publicizing them. Mike to attend Town Council on January 23 to answer questions from Council.

- November 6th election... Based on 987 new registers on election day and the over 7000 voters (approximately 80% turnout), future Presidential elections should plan for as many as 20 volunteers to help the Supervisors. The process in November 2012 went well because of last minute volunteers, including ballot clerks who gave assistance.

The Attorney General is investigating one voter who registered mistakenly to vote in Hooksett. Clarification is being sought for other voters, per letters sent since the election.

2013-2014 budget is in progress under the guidance of the Town Moderator as Chairman of the Board of Elections.

NEW BUSINESS

Mike Horne to be reimbursed for \$9.00 in postage for letters mailed to verify voters.

February 8 is the School Deliberative Session, and March 12 is the School Election.
April 6 is the Deliberative Session for Town Meeting, and May 14 is the Town Election.

Redistricting should happen no later than March 26, when the filing period for Town Election begins.

Mike Horne to send out letters regarding voters moving into Hooksett from other states.

Patricia Demers purchased a copy of the Check List in January 2013.

VOTER REGISTRATIONS AND CHANGES

- Approved removal of 344 voters who moved from Hooksett to other towns
- Approved 9 voters Pending Supervisor Approval

- Approved 2 voters in status of pending removal
