EDSAT

This is a one-time request to enable the Town to contract with Northeastern University to undergo the EDSAT community economic development evaluation process. EDSAT, standing for "Economic Development Self-Assessment Tool", facilitates focused planning and evaluation of a community's economic development needs. Hudson's capacity for economic development is explored in detail through ten assessment categories to better understand our strengths and weaknesses, assets and strategic benefits. The process includes the participation of public officials, community leaders, municipal staff, and others. At the end of the project, the community can expect to develop implementable strategies with short term and long term objectives to help move us forward on economic development priorities. This is essential to Hudson at this unique juncture because of the recent loss of Intel employment and more than 5 large properties up for sale in the Downtown. EDSAT will enable us to bring in renowned professor, Barry Bluestone, to facilitate this in depth evaluation and help us position Hudson to attract new businesses to fill the gaps created by the recent changes in our community.
