- Commissioner Thompson was able to purchase two more anchors from Walmart for \$43.00 for buoys
- Buoys to be pulled from the lake this week or next.
- Dave Grasso will staff attendants on the last two Saturdays and Sundays in September at the Hixson Launch. Commissioners will be on call for residents that need to remove their boats on the first two Saturdays and Sundays in October
- Discussion held regarding the commission's recommendation for charging a fee to launch at the Hixson boat launch. Memo will be sent to Dave Grasso.
- Bruce Lafrenier requested information on constructing two docks on his property. Commissioner Thompson told him that docks can not be permanent and must be less than 50 feet from the water line unless permission is granted by the commission.
- Letter to be sent to the Fort Meadow Ski club regarding the need for proper upkeep of the jump, including repair, lighting and insurance binder.
- Shared drive is up and running for Commission use
- Purchase of 4 more anchors for buoy moorings will be held off until spring
