A vote was taken on the following warrant articles:

Article 1 : FY08 Budget: The finance committee reviewed each line item and unanimously recommends the dollar amounts as submitted by the Executive assistant without change.

Article 2: Capital Plan: The finance committee unanimously recommends the adoption of the subject matter of this article and that a sum of \$711,751 be taken from available funds. (the vote for each of the eleven items was 7-0 in all categories)

Article 3:Reserve Fund: The finance committee unanimously recommends the adoption of the subject matter of this article and that a sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) be raised and appropriated to carry into effect the provisions of this article.

Article 4:Stabilization Fund: The finance committee unanimously recommends the adoption of the subject matter of this article.
