- 3. Five (5) Year Financial Projections
  - Mr. Lemnios presented override scenarios projecting level funded, 2%, 3% and 4% growth factors and how long that revenue increase would sustain the town before additional money would be required again.
  - Discussion stressed that the scenarios do not include a capital expenditure plan to tackle issues regarding town hall, roadways, seawalls etc. These are just to maintain the town services and facilities as is.
  - Discussed Chapter 90 funds which is the return of gas tax revenue to the town. Focus of these monies will return to road repair.
  - A request was made for an updated debt schedule for three schools.
  - A request was made to include a debt exclusion scenario to see if that would alleviate pressure to the operating budget.

Request would include scenario of all school debt as an exclusion not just the high school

- Reviewed projections based on an overall large override in 2010 with remaining monies being put into stabilization fund and how long that would sustain the town budgets.
- Distributed and reviewed tax impact on homes values.
- Discussion regarding increasing user fees across all departments to remain comparable with other town.
- Discussion regarding Memorial School and feasibility of turning it into a town hall/library/senior center.
- Mr. Lampke distributed guidelines regarding use of emails and how town employees, elected official and appointed officials can handle override information.
