This article seeks to pay the costs of repair, rehabilitation, replacement, and/or relocation of sewers for Pump Station No. 9 interceptor and section s of sewer line from the Pemberton pump station and other areas of the town. The sewer line walls are wearing down and in danger of failure. We have had a couple of failures last year two week apart. The monies would be appropriated by a \$1 Million Bond authorization. This bond would be repaid via sewer rates (enterprise fund) and not the tax base. Most likely the cost will be more in the \$600,000-\$800,000 range.
