## **Town Manager Update**

#### **School Department Budget (Dr. Tyrell)**

- 2.75% increase request, reluctantly deferred counselling services for students (mental health)
- Several veteran teachers have retired which helped from a budgetary standpoint for FY2017
- Requesting a 0.3 FTE increase in Special Education Teaching at the High School
- Hull purchases in a cooperative for school and custodial supplies (group of 50 schools)
- Hull purchases heat in a cooperative also
- Hull High School offers access to a cooperative where students can access courses that may not be offered at Hull High School
- 0 2 students annually apply to the South Shore Vocational Technology School
- The \$600K in building repairs would not impact the likelihood of school consolidation; the repairs must be made either way; having the repairs done would not preclude the building being used for other purposes; the state cannot say no, but they must notify the MSVA
- The Middle School envelope was not addressed during the rehabilitation efforts of years past
- There is no raise in the teachers' pay budget for this year; negotiations are still ongoing
- Hull High School SAT scores are bouncing up and down; in general, Hull is below the state average, and above the national average
- Detailed presentations with test scores are available on the school committee's website
- Students that took the PARCC tests on the computers had a difficult time; this year they will be using paper and pencil

#### **Articles 23 and 24 (Special Capitalization Fund)**

- Article 23 moves the money into the account
- COC will make a recommendation to the BoS to transfer almost the full amount
- Not obligated annually to spend money out of the stabilization fund
