New action items:

- 3. Plan to attend the next scheduled Beach Management Committee meeting.
- 4. Contact the Highway Department to find out what kind of beach access plan is currently in place.
- 5. Review the Apollo Building architectural plans for ADA issues.
- 6. Contact the DCR for information on handicapped parking at Nantasket Beach.
- 7. Look into ways to add more handicapped parking spaces at Pemberton Pier.

Other items:

- 1. Judi Saide has rebuilt the Commission's web site.
- 2. Work has begun on Main St. from the Water Treatment Plant to Pemberton. We need to be aware of ADA compliance in conjunction with construction.
