7:55 pm Discussion of updating of FEMA maps for Hull

Ocean and Coastal Consultants have a contract to begin the process to update the FEMA maps for Hull. Tim Hillier reviewed the process for updating the maps and responded to questions from the Commission about the process and procedures they will use. The Commission reviewed a map of Hull and indicated areas that should receive particular attention due to flooding concerns and/or map inaccuracies.

9:30 Approval of Enforcement Order.

Anne Herbst reported that she issued an Enforcement Order at 2 Bluff Avenue for unpermitted activity in the buffer to a Coastal Bank. The EO includes a cease and desist order and requires the owner to file a NOI for the activity.

Approve the Enforcement Order issued for 2 Bluff Avenue.

9:33 Update on permit approval procedures.

Anne Herbst provided a copy of a new form that the Building Department will use to make sure projects that fall under the jurisdiction of the Conservation Commission are reviewed by the Conservation Administrator. The form requires applicants to get sign-off from the Conservation Department.

9:34 Update on highway department.

Anne Herbst reported that the Highway Department requested consultation on a road flooding situation near wetlands.

9:35 Approval of letter to Library Trustees

The Commission reviewed a letter drafted by Sheila Connor in response to a request from Peter Seitz, Chair of the Library Trustees. The letter confirmed that the Commission had provided consultation about early plans for a new library. Commissioners expressed concern that no specific approvals could be offered since the permit process has yet to be taken up. It was agreed that the draft was appropriate for this stage of the process.

Upon a **motion** by S. Das and **2nd** by J. Reineck and a **vote** of 6/0/0; It was voted to:

Approve and sign the letter. The letter was signed.

9:40 Discussion of response to the request for Superceding Order of Conditions for Nantasket Beachfront Condominiums.

After discussion, it was agreed that a response to the request should be drafted. It was also Agreed that Town Counsel Lampke should be consulted prior to sending a final response. Finally, it was agreed to place this topic on the agenda for January 10, 2006.
