Owner/Applicant: Genevieve Sartell, Ernest Sartell

Ms. Sartell made a complete presentation of the project which is to include construction of a one-level deck, 42 feet long and 12 feet wide. The deck will be constructed on ten sonotubes with the height being 30 inches from the ground. The decking will be installed at an angle with ½" spacing to allow water to flow through. The sonotubes will be installed in line with the existing pilings under the house.

The deck will be located at the rear of the house. The house is at a distance between 33 and 39 feet away from the toe of the seawall.

An abutter expressed his concerns that the installation of sonotubes is like filling the land and was concerned that water would flow through this site and onto adjacent properties. The Commission explained to the abutter that the law does not allow for obstruction of the water flow and that the deck should be designed to allow water to flow freely under it. An Abutter requested that the Commission have a soil analysis performed. The Commission did not feel that this was necessary.

Upon a motion by J. Hass and 2nd by P. Paquin and a vote of 4/0/0;

It was **voted** to:

Close the Public Hearing, **approve** the project and to discuss the Draft Order of Conditions. The Order of Conditions was **signed**.
