7:35pm Opposite 1145 Nantasket Avenue, Map 07/Lot 20 Opening of a public hearing on the Request

for Determination of Applicability filed by Hull Sewer for work described as temporary excavation

for sewer pipe assessment.

Applicant: Ed Petrilak

Mr. Petrilak presented the project that is to involve digging an area approximately 6 feet long, 3 feet wide and down 5 ½ feet to expose a sewer pipe to complete investigative testing. It is Mr. Petrilak's hope that he may even be able to dig a smaller area once the pipe is located. If needed, Mr. Petrilak may have to offset the original location by 20 feet toward the east. All work will be completed in one day.

7:55pm Corner of Samoset and Coburn, Map 21/Lot 021 (SE35-1101) Opening of a public hearing on

the Notice of Intent filed by Michael Bolea for work described as construction of a single family

home.

Owner/Applicant: Michael Bolea Representative: Jason Scott

Abutters/Others: Steve Buckley, Ruth Kostka

Mr. Scott presented the project that is to construct a single family home on an existing empty lot. The home will be built with a FEMA compliant foundation with smart vents. Mr. Scott indicated that the draft flood maps indicate an elevation of 10. The first floor elevation would be at 12, which results in a 2 foot freeboard situation.

A letter from Stanley Humphries from LEC Environmental was submitted stating that in his opinion, the site, although a dune in a barrier beach is non-significant to the interests of storm damage prevention and flood control.

The Commission questioned where the utilities would be brought in. Mr. Scott stated that they would come in off of Samoset Ave. The Commission also questioned the surface of the proposed driveway. Mr. Scott stated that it would be paved with bituminous concrete.

A Special Condition will be added as follows:

- The Conservation Commission finds that the coastal dune in this location is not significant to the interests of flood control and storm damage protection.
