7:40pm Discussion of dune damage with DPW director

Mr. Stigliani provided the Commission with a sample of the type of roadway marker to be used along the foot of the dune on Beach Ave. to prevent future damage from snow plowing/removal activities. The markers will be installed into the pavement approximately 40 feet apart delineating either the 18-foot width of the road, or at the foot of the dune where the dune has encroached into the 18 foot road width. The Conservation Administrator will work with the DPW to determine exact placement of the markers.

The DPW will begin removal of debris and spreading the sand as soon as conditions allow. The Conservation Administrator will supervise this work. The DPW staff will be scheduled to plant beach grass on March 26, 2010.
