**7:30pm** Chair Connor called the meeting to order

**7:40pm 51 Beach Avenue, Map 25/Lot 083 Opening** of a public hearing on the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by M. Daniel Gordon for work described as construct deck.

Owner/Applicant: Dan & Fredda Gordon

Documents: Hand drawn plan (3 pages) submitted with RDA

Mr. Gordon presented the project to construct a 20 foot by 24 foot deck at the rear of the home. The deck will be supported by concrete footings. A stairway will be constructed with access via 2 sets of stairs.

The Commission asked Mr. Gordon what was planned for the ground surface that will be below the deck. Mr. Gordon stated that it would remain as is and concrete would only be removed if necessary for construction of a footing.

It was voted to:

Mr. Feenan presented the project that is to replace an existing gravel parking area with permeable pavers. The grading would remain about the same with a 6" flush curb at the roadway to prevent damage by snowplows. Two granite steps will be placed at grade. Granite curbing will be placed at edges to prevent vehicles from going off the paved area.

8:30pm Discussion of Enforcement Order issued to 158 Manomet Ave.

Attendees: Judith Slawsby, Stanley Slawsby, Mitch & Sharon Fishman, Stuart Slawsby, Roberta Balduzzi.

This discussion is being held after issuance of an Enforcement Order issued August 24, 2010 to Judith Slawsby for removal of vegetation on the primary dune and activity that lowered the height of the dune and moved material on the coastal beach.

Vice Chair Hass read an email to the Commission from Mr. John Cavoores dated 9/23/2010. Ms. Slawsby read from a prepared statement. In her statement, Ms. Slawsby admitted pulling out a "poisonous" weed from the dune. She also stated that she crosses over the dune on a path that in her opinion is "grand fathered" and not subject to the regulations of the Wetlands Protection Act (WPA).

The Commission advised Ms. Slawsby that the dune is protected by the WPA and therefore no one should be walking on the dune or removing vegetation regardless of ownership.

Motion by P. Epstein and 2nd by J. Meschino and a vote of 5/0/2 (J. Hass, M. Horn abstained); It was voted to:

Issue an order for Ms. Slawsby to replant the path over the dune and refrain from walking to on the dune.
