Mr. Ray presented the project that is to construct a single family home on an existing empty flat lot. The home will be constructed with a FEMA compliant foundation with flow through vents. The foundation system will allow for three feet of freeboard above the draft flood maps. The driveway will be constructed as a permeable surface as noted by Mr. Ray on the plans. The hedge along N Street will be removed.

Mr. Ray referred to correspondence from LEC regarding the resource areas. All abutters present spoke in favor of the proposed home.

A Special Condition was added as follows:

- The Conservation Commission finds that the coastal dune in this location is not significant to the interests
 of flood control and storm damage protection.
 - Upon a motion by J. Hass and 2nd by M. Horn and a vote of 5/0/0;

It was voted to:

Close the Public Hearing, **approve** the project and to discuss the Draft Order of Conditions. The Order of Conditions was **signed**.

Other Business:
