**7:30pm** Chair Connor called the meeting to order

7:35pm 67 Gosnold St., Map 44/Lot 138A (SE35-1155) Continuation of a public hearing on the Notice of

Intent filed by Craig DeNicola for work described as demolish existing home, construct new single

family home and driveway.

Owner/Applicant: Craig DeNicola Representative: Al Vautrinot

Mr. Vautrinot submitted a revised Plan of Land that indicated areas of fill on the site in addition to correspondence from Benjamin Gilmore, PE with results of soil samples. This information was requested by the Commission at a previous hearing. Mr. Vautrinot informed the Commission that he reviewed the placement of the home on the site with respect to relocating it closer to the street and found that it would not be feasible due to the location of the driveway and the Owner's ease in backing up in the driveway. Mr. Vautrinot stated that the first floor will be at elevation 14.2. The Commission questioned the type of footings to be used. Mr. Vautrinot stated that sonotubes will be used and the deck will be partially cantilevered.

Mr. Vautrinot stated that the top of the coastal bank is located at the edge of the resource area. The Commission discussed the vegetated area located at the top of the coastal bank as well as protecting the bank during and after construction.

The Commission inquired about the volleyball court that is partially located on the Applicant's property. Mr. DeNicola stated that he did not plan for any changes to it.

Special Conditions were added as follows:

- A hay bale and silt fence line must be established at least ten feet from the top of the coastal bank before the start of any permitted work.
- The first five feet from the top of the coastal bank must remain vegetated. This condition is ongoing and will not expire at the end of three years.
- Upon a motion by P. Paquin and 2nd by M. Horn and a vote of 5/0/0;

It was **voted** to:

**Close** the Public Hearing, **approve** the project and to discuss the Draft Order of Conditions. The Order of Conditions was **signed**.

On a separate matter, Mr. Vautrinot provided the Commission with information from the State of Connecticut pertaining to Phragmites.

8:00pm Railroad bed in the vicinity of Main St., Ocean Ave., and Nantasket Ave., Maps 2, 3, 56, 57 and 7 (SE35-1160) Opening of a public hearing on the Notice of Intent filed by Edward Petrilak for work described as replace sewer main using trenchless technology.

Documents: Final Plans submitted at meeting (14 Sheets), stamped 6/22/2011 marked as Plan of Record

Mr. Schrader presented the project that is to replace approximately 5,000 feet of underground sewer piping utilizing trenchless technology. Heavy duty off road equipment will be used to transverse over areas with large rocks. Where necessary, an excavator will move and then replace and stabilize any rocks on banks or revetments. Selective trimming of vegetation will be done where necessary to complete work.

The Commission and Mr. Schrader discussed the need for special care to be taken to prevent damage to the resource areas.

A Special Condition was added as follows:

- The selected contractor must meet with the Conservation Administrator before the start of work to review plans and procedures for the work and any need for mitigation. The meeting must include a site walk of the project area.
- Upon a motion by P. Paquin and 2nd by M. Horn and a vote of 5/0/0;

It was **voted** to:

**Close** the Public Hearing, **approve** the project and to discuss the Draft Order of Conditions. The Order of Conditions was **signed**.
