7:45pm 2 Samoset Ave., Map 27/Lot 034 (SE35-1169) Opening of a Public Hearing on the Notice of Intent filed by Hull Redevelopment Authority for work described as Demolish Building.

Mr. DiVito reviewed the project. The building and foundation will be removed and the area backfilled with sand. The waste will go to Graham Waste. The gas connection has already been severed and the sewer connection capped. The water line will be capped as well. Special Conditions were added as follows:

- The building and foundation must be completely removed from the site and not buried in place.
- Material used to backfill the foundation shall be comparable to the material on the site.
- Upon a motion by M. Horn and 2nd by P. Epstein and a vote of 4/0/0; It was voted to: Close the Public Hearing, and approve the project. The Order of Conditions was signed.

The applicant had intended to use the current foundation and rebuild the building in its current footprint, but the foundation is too damaged for reuse. Because the footprint of the building is changing, the project will need to go before the Zoning Board of Appeals. If the project changes the applicant will request an amended Notice of Intent. The project will eliminate basement apartments and provide 3 feet of freeboard on a FEMA compliant foundation. The garage will be removed and a paved loop road around the property installed. Parking areas will be gravel and the total impervious area will remain approximately the same.

Special Conditions were added as follows:

- The Conservation Commission finds that the coastal dune in this location is not significant to the interests of flood control and storm damage protection.
- All subsurface pipes and other materials must be removed from the site.
